## PROHIBITED ITEMS POLICY

Students are not permitted to bring the following items to school:

- Permanent Markers
- Liquid White Out
- Steel rulers
- Chewing Gum
- Jelly Crystals
- Energy Drinks/Soft drinks
- Aerosol Cans
- Lasers pointers
- Tools, for example spanners, screwdrivers, etc.
- Lighters, matches and other fire making equipment
- Tobacco
- Vapes
- Soda bulbs
- Alcohol
- Illicit Drugs
- Drug paraphernalia
- Items that display offensive language/images
- Weapons or items that could be used as a weapon
- Boom boxes
- Bluetooth speakers
- Medication
  - Students are only permitted to have on their person medication that is a part of a Health Plan that has been developed by the State Schools Nurse and approved by the Principal. All other medication must be kept at the office.
