Do I need to live in the Gordonvale Catchment to be accepted into the SUMMIT Program?

- NAPLAN (most recent)
- Certificates
- Supporting documentation provided may be considered (eg. letters from current teachers)

How many places are offered each year?

• Up to 28 in each SUMMIT class

When will we be advised of the status of our SUMMIT application?

- The first round of SUMMIT offers are typically made late Term 3. Subsequent offers are made throughout the remainder of the school year.
- All SUMMIT applicants will still be required to complete the Gordonvale State High School enrolment interview including the enrolment pack.

Do I have to be a representative Touch Player to apply for the Touch Football SUMMIT Program?

 No. The school will hold Touch Football trials during Term 4 to finalise selection. Students will be selected on the basis of their ability to learn new skills, game play, drills and sportsmanship.

WHAT IS THE FOCUS?

The focus of the Gordonvale State High School SUMMIT Program is on the learning areas of English/Humanities, Maths/Science and Touch Football. Students can apply to participate in all core subjects, including Touch Football or any combination which meets their learning needs and aspirations. Students combine with the remainder of their cohort for all other subjects.

The program has an emphasis on developing 21st Century Thinking Skills and participation in extension activities including competitions, projects and sporting carnivals. In the initial years there is special emphasis on individual learning projects.

QUALITY OPPORTUNITY EXCELLENCE

Who should apply?

SUMMIT students have a love of learning. They perform well academically and/or in Touch Football, are highly motivated and flourish in learning environments that support and extend critical and creative thinking. Current year 6 students who demonstrate outstanding academic and/or a high level of engagement in Touch Football (performance and officiating) as well as excellent behaviour and effort are encouraged to apply.





THE SUMMIT PROGRAM AND SENIOR SCHOOLING

Within their senior schooling (Years 11 and 12) students will have the opportunity to select Australian Tertiary Admissions Ranking (ATAR) subjects and be part of a range of extracurricular high extension activites, state and national competitions and programs.
