Subjects marked with an asterisk (*) are Authority Registered or Vocational subjects. These subjects provide credit towards the QCE, but are not considered in awarding an OP. Students need to complete 5 Authority Subjects for 4 Semesters to be eligible for an OP.

Students and carers should be aware that some subjects may be full or may not be able to be offered due to insufficient numbers. Some of these subjects may be available through eLearning. No guarantees of enrolment into any subjects can be given.

Separate enrolment processes are required for subjects offered through eLearning. These may include Accounting, Maths C, Japanese, Cert III Children's Services, IPT, Geography. Students may only enrol in one eLearning subject.

Some subjects have prerequisites that must be met. Please refer to the Senior Secondary Subject Handbook for information about subjects and prerequisites.
